Our mission is to demonstrate the light and love of Jesus Christ to the people of the eastside of Flint. We are compelled by Christ's life and called to act in His behalf in our community.

Services provided to our community...

Food Pantry: Over 9000 men, women and children served in 2006, 303 new families & individuals were added to our list, in February 2008 with a total served of 496.

Hot Lunches: Between 100 and 150 people come four to four days per week for lunch at Eastside Mission.

Clothing: Clothing available for all ages and sizes, plus household items and appliances.

Infants: 60 families were served in February and over 88 infants were provided diapers, formula, clothing and other needs in the first two months of 2008.

Eye Care: Dr. Chris comes in twice each month for eye exams and glasses for those in need.

Medical Help: A volunteer nurse answers health questions once each week.

Resource: We help direct clients to area agencies when we are unable to help them, Health Access has added an office in our building to facilitate additional referrals.

Free Haircuts: Once each month a local beautician provides this service to clients.

Chiropractic: A volunteer Chiropractor visits monthly to do adjustments free of charge.
